

CALIFORNIA WALNUT BREAD

3 cups all-purpose flour
1 cup granulated sugar
4 tsp. baking powder
1 tsp. salt
 $\frac{3}{4}$ cup shortening

$1\frac{1}{2}$ cups coarsely chopped
Diamond Walnuts
1 egg, beaten
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ cups milk
1 tsp. vanilla

Into mixing bowl sift flour with sugar, baking powder and salt. Cut in shortening. Stir in $1\frac{1}{4}$ cups of the walnuts. Add egg, milk and vanilla. Mix just until ingredients are blended. Turn into greased and floured 9x5-inch loaf pan. Sprinkle remaining $\frac{1}{4}$ cup walnuts over top. Bake at 350° F. for 60 to 70 minutes or until loaf tests done. Let stand in pan 10 minutes. Turn out onto wire rack to cool. Makes 1 loaf.

Your best first step would be to send a letter to the contractor, explaining your position. Then, if

In sorting out your obligations, you should first reread any written contract signed by you and the broker. What does it say about "second thoughts" or "a change of heart"? Is there an escape clause that allows you to withdraw from the agreement? If so, you might not be liable.
