

FRESH APPLE CAKE

2 cups chopped or coarsely grated apple,
unpeeled (about 4 medium-size)

1 cup sugar

1 egg, beaten

1/2 cup cooking oil

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

1 1/2 cups unsifted all-purpose flour

1 scant teaspoon baking soda

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg

1. Blend sugar with apples and let stand
30 minutes.

2. Add beaten egg, oil and vanilla to apple
and sugar mixture. Add all dry ingredients
and stir until well mixed.

3. Bake in preheated 350°F. oven in
greased 8 x 8 x 2-inch pan or 7 x 11 x 2-
inch pan for 35 to 40 minutes.
