OLD FASHIONED APPLE CRISP

- 4 c. sliced apples
- 1 tsp. cinnamon
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1/4 c. water
- 3/4 c. flour
- 1 c. granulated sugar
- 1/3 c. butter

Butter 8" x 8" square baking dish. Place sliced apples in dish. Sprinkle with cinnamon, salt and water. In small bowl, rub together flour, sugar and butter. Drop mixture over apples. Bake at 350° for 40 minutes. Serves 4-6.
