

## White Mountain Icing

Stir until well blended in small saucepan:  $\frac{1}{2}$  c.  
sugar,  $\frac{1}{4}$  c. white corn syrup, 2 T. water.

Boil rapidly until mixture spins a 6 to 8-in. thread  
or 242.

When mixture begins to boil, beat . . . . 2 egg whites  
Beat until stiff enough to hold a peak.

Pour hot syrup slowly in thin steady stream into  
beaten egg whites, beating constantly with electric  
or rotary beater until mixture stands in very stiff  
peaks. Blend in . . .  $\frac{1}{2}$  t. vanilla.
